



ClassLink is a single sign-on platform that will allow students to use one username and password to access online resources already being used in the classroom.

Here is how to get started at home:

1. Go to this website: <https://launchpad.classlink.com/danvillesd> or click on ClassLink from the Students Directory Links on the District website.
2. Students will select “Sign in with Google” and enter their Google Email account credentials, **including** the @danvillesd.org portion. This is the same username and password that students use to log into a Chromebook.
3. Click on the “Sign In” button. **If your browser brings up pop-ups asking to save passwords, always click on “Never”.**
4. Students should now see all of the applications assigned to their grade level and/or school.
5. Some single sign-on applications require the use of a browser extension/add-on. If you are prompted to add this extension, the following links will guide you through the process of installing the extension/add-on for your preferred browser:

6. Many applications have the student’s username and password already loaded into ClassLink. If the application does not have a preloaded username and password, the student, after clicking on the application, will get a screen asking for the username and password. Once the student inputs the username and password for the application, the credentials will be stored in their password locker and will not need to be entered again. **NOTE:** If students saved the wrong login information when prompted, they will need to edit the username and password in their ClassLink password locker.
