

Danville Middle School Social Policy

The Danville Middle School holds socials throughout the year. These socials are a privilege NOT a right. Students with a record of good behavior are allowed to attend. If a student is disciplined by administration between socials, they may be prohibited from attending one or more socials. Discipline includes, but is not limited to, chronic disciplinary infractions, after-school detention, in school suspension and out of school suspension.

Socials are for Danville Area Middle School students only. Students who attend the socials are expected to abide by the rules. Failure to do so may result in disciplinary action. The rules for the socials are as follows:

- All Danville Middle School rules apply (see Student Handbook).
- Students are only permitted to sit on the bleachers which are pulled out.
- No public displays of affection.
- All food and beverages must remain in the cafeteria.
- Students should throw away all trash and clean up after themselves in the cafeteria.
- Students should not leave food or drinks unattended.
- Students will not be permitted to enter any areas of the school that are not a part of the social, including student lockers, hallways, and classrooms.
- Students are responsible for all personal items.
- Students are expected to stay at the social until the end. If a student leaves the social prior to the scheduled end time, they will not be permitted to return into the school building. **Students and parents are expected to be responsible for all departure arrangements, including if a student is walking home and/or leaving with a friend or that friend's parents.**
- Students are expected to be picked up or depart school property at the scheduled end time.
- Outside doors will not be opened until the scheduled start time of the social.
- If a social is scheduled to start at the end of the school day (for example, 3:15 or 3:30), students are not permitted to leave the building and then return to the school for the social unless prior approval has been given directly to the parent or guardian by a school administrator. In cases where this may be necessary, parents/guardians should contact the school administration by phone, email, or written note prior to the day of the social.
